The new website was made possible by a Service Grant through the Taproot Foundation. Taproot's website designers took the existing Parent Trust website and helped provide the additional expertise and tools Parent Trust needed to building a larger and more sophisticated web presence. The new website is now organized and updated using a new content management system and specifically designed page templates that help to create a branded, cohesive online look. The result is a more robust online searchable database and easier to navigate program and informational pages.

Parent Trust's website has the only statewide online database (<http://www.parenttrust.org/families/community-resources/>) that provides parents, caregivers, and anyone else interested, with custom information about family resources available in their community. The database is free, available 24 hours a day, and searches for resources based on the user's city or zip code. Users can find parenting and family classes, support groups, events and resources.
